Dear First Selectman Burbank:

Congratulations! Your request for the Town of Andover's second Bright Idea Grant of \$5,000 has been approved. The Bright Idea Grant will be used to pay for a Light Bulb Swap held on November 12th, 2016 at the Andover Town Hall. Andover residents will be able to exchange old incandescent and CFL bulbs for up to five energy-efficient LED light bulbs, free of charge. We are pleased that the Town of Andover has invested its second Bright Idea Grant to enhance residential energy savings through its promotion of high efficiency lighting, which will allow residents to reduce their overall energy consumption at home. This event served 100 homes, providing residents a combined, lifetime savings of 614,349 kWh. The remainder of the grant dollars will be used on a future energy efficiency project.

Energize Connecticut's Clean Energy Communities program was designed to encourage Connecticut towns and cities to reduce their energy consumption through energy efficiency and to invest in clean, renewable energy sources. Bright Idea Grants are earned through the accumulation of 100 points, which are awarded for participation in Energize Connecticut's energy-saving programs administered by Eversource.

Enclosed, you will find a check for \$4,165 and a copy of the executed Bright Idea Grant agreement for your records. TechniArt will be paid directly for the cost of the LED bulbs.
